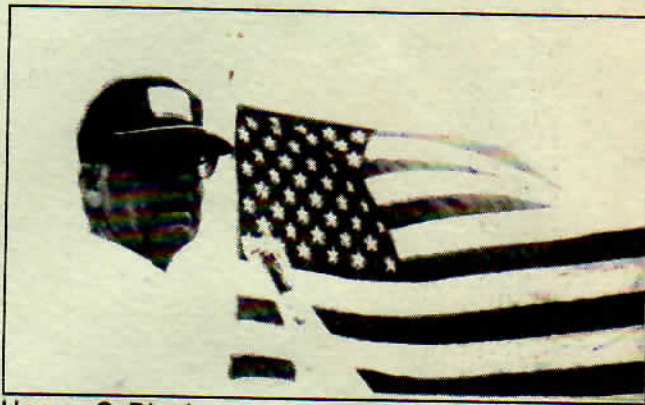

REMEMBERS

Harvey C. Black



This year's Memorial Bicycle Races are held in the memory of Harvey C. Black, 15 year member of the Association. Harvey Black's career in cycling spanned 57 years, and he was a familiar figure in American cycling.

Harvey Black began his bicycle racing career as a protege

of the legendary Reggie "Ironman" McNamara. Black was a Junior Amateur Champion, and soon entered the professional ranks. He was a top 6-Day rider, and excelled in tandem racing and tandem pacing. He served as an official in professional racing, and served on the National Board of the ABLA (now the USCF).

For many years Harvey C. Black has been a familiar face on the judges stands of bicycle races up and down the Eastern Seaboard. He was always a willing and helpful hand on race days. He promoted several amateur races on the East Coast, and perhaps is best known as the promoter/director of the Annual July 4th "Holiday at Home" Races in Rahway, N.J.

Outside of cycling, Black was very involved with Cardiovascular Medicine and received awards for his pioneering contribution to open heart surgery.

Harvey Black will be remembered for his lifelong love for cycling and his dedication to the cause of the sport.
